

## INSURANCE REQUIREMENT

RE: Home Insurance Policy

DEAR POTENTIAL SOLAR CUSTOMER,

As a part of the requirements for our net metered parallel generation systems we are required by the Wisconsin Public Service Commission to keep a copy of a current, up to date insurance policy. Please see below for a reference from the Distributed Generation Interconnection Agreement that needs to be signed and submitted to Northwestern Wisconsin Electric Company (NWE).

“Throughout the term of this Agreement, Application shall carry a liability Insurance policy that provided protection against claims for damages resulting from (i) bodily injury, including wrongful death; and (ii) property damage arising out of Applicants ownership and/or operation of the DG Facility under this agreement. For systems under 20 kw the limits of such policy shall be at least \$300,000 per occurrence and systems over 20kw require a minimum of \$1,000,000 (must add Northwestern Wisconsin Electric Company as an additional insured) or prove financial responsibility by another method acceptable, and approved in writing, to Public Utility. The failure of the Application or Public Utility to enforce the minimum levels of insurance does not relieve the Application from maintaining such levels of insurance or relieve Applicant of any liability. Prior to execution of this agreement applicant shall provide Public Utility with a certificate of insurance containing a minimum 30-day notice of cancellation.”

Should you decide to become a solar customer with NWE we will need to obtain proof of insurance from you. Lastly, if your insurance provider can simply send NWE proof of insurance upon your annual renewal automatically that would work best going forward.
