DIRECT PAYMENT PLAN

Northwestern Wisconsin Electric (NWE) is pleased to offer you a Direct Payment Plan. Now you can have your monthly electric payment made automatically from your checking or savings account, regardless of where you do your banking.

The Direct Payment Plan will help you in several ways:

- It saves time because there are fewer checks to write each month.
- Helps you meet your commitment in a timely manner even if you're away from home.
- No problem with lost or misplaced bills.
- It helps maintain good credit.
- Saves postage costs.
- No late charges, ever.
- It's easy to sign-up, easy to cancel and it's free.

Here's how NWE's Direct Payment Plan works:

Once you have notified NWE of your interest in the Direct Payment Plan and have completed a form to authorize Direct Payment it may take up to one month to process this information. A transfer file will be set up approximately 17 days after the bill is mailed. **Your payment will be made electronically from your financial institution on the due date on the bill. The automatic deduction will appear on your bill as "PAID BY BANK DRAFTED ON" with the date deducted and will appear on your bank statement each month. If you change banks, accounts or wish to cancel we need to be notified four days prior to the automatic deduction date on your bill.**
